- Operational M&E tools.

1. 40 members trained and skilled to provide effective leadership based on common understanding of SARD-Net.
2. Development of policies, approaches and processes
3. 24 cell leaders targeted.
4. 9 members of the NMC.
5. 150 cell members trained and skilled to provide effective leadership based on common understanding of SARD-Net.
6. 13 lap top computers and 13 cell phones to Cells for effective coordination.

Enhanced sustainable livelihoods of target geographical rural communities in 60 geographical rural villages (over 50,000 small holder farmers) within SARD-Net operational areas through the promotion of sustainable agriculture as strategy for rural development in Uganda

(b) 60 target geographical rural communities with capacity and capability and effectively and efficiently developing need-based community development project proposals.

1. 96 (8) villages per each of the 12 cells surveyed to provide a socio, economic and environmental baseline data base.
2. 5 villages per cell identified for development of community need based projects for possible funding.
3. 60 participatory and professionally prepared community based development proposals developed.
4. At least 5 learning, 5 resources and 5 positioning partners identified that are committed to work in partnership with target rural communities.

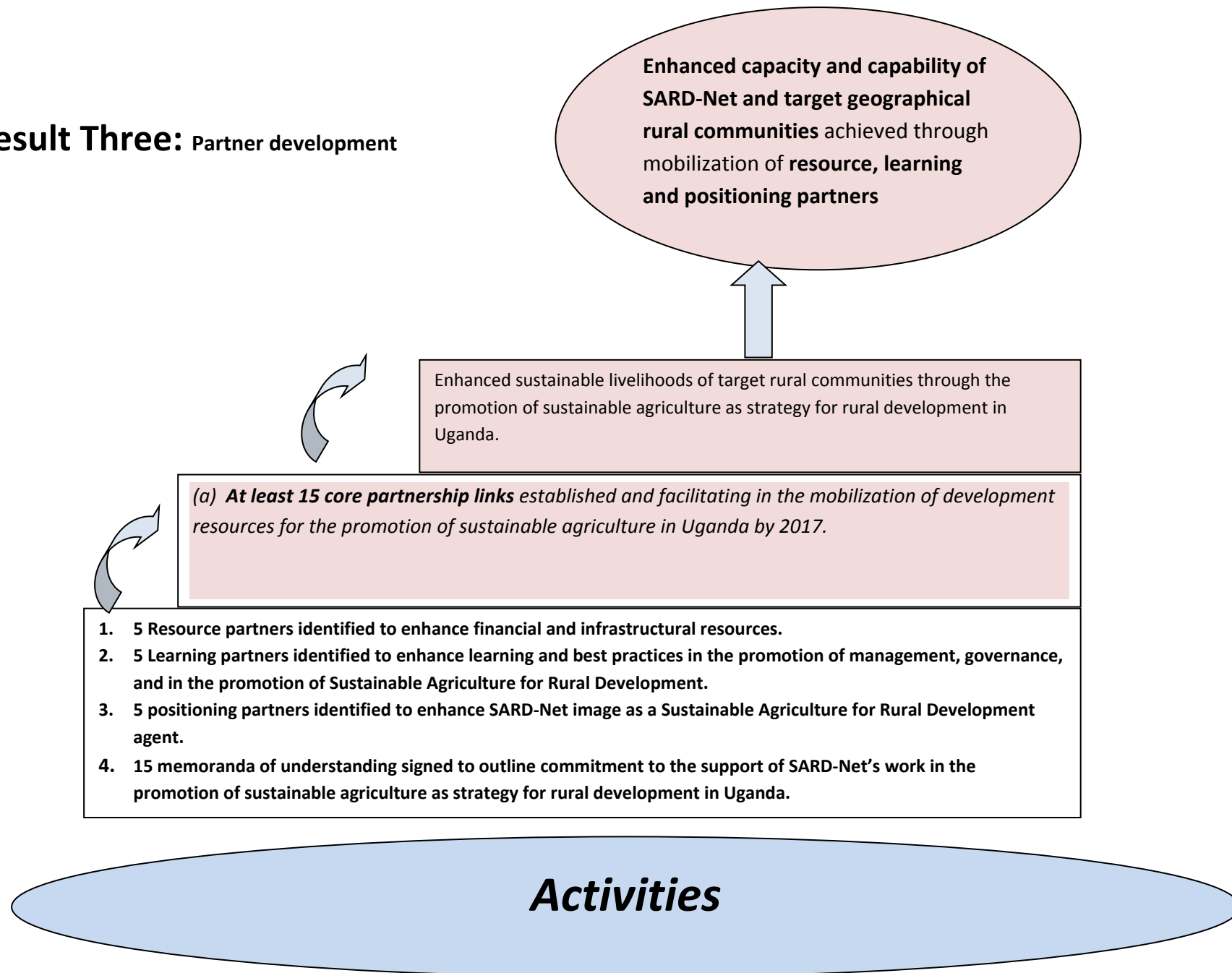
